**LOCATION:** CUSCO, SACRED VALLEY, MACHU PICCHU.

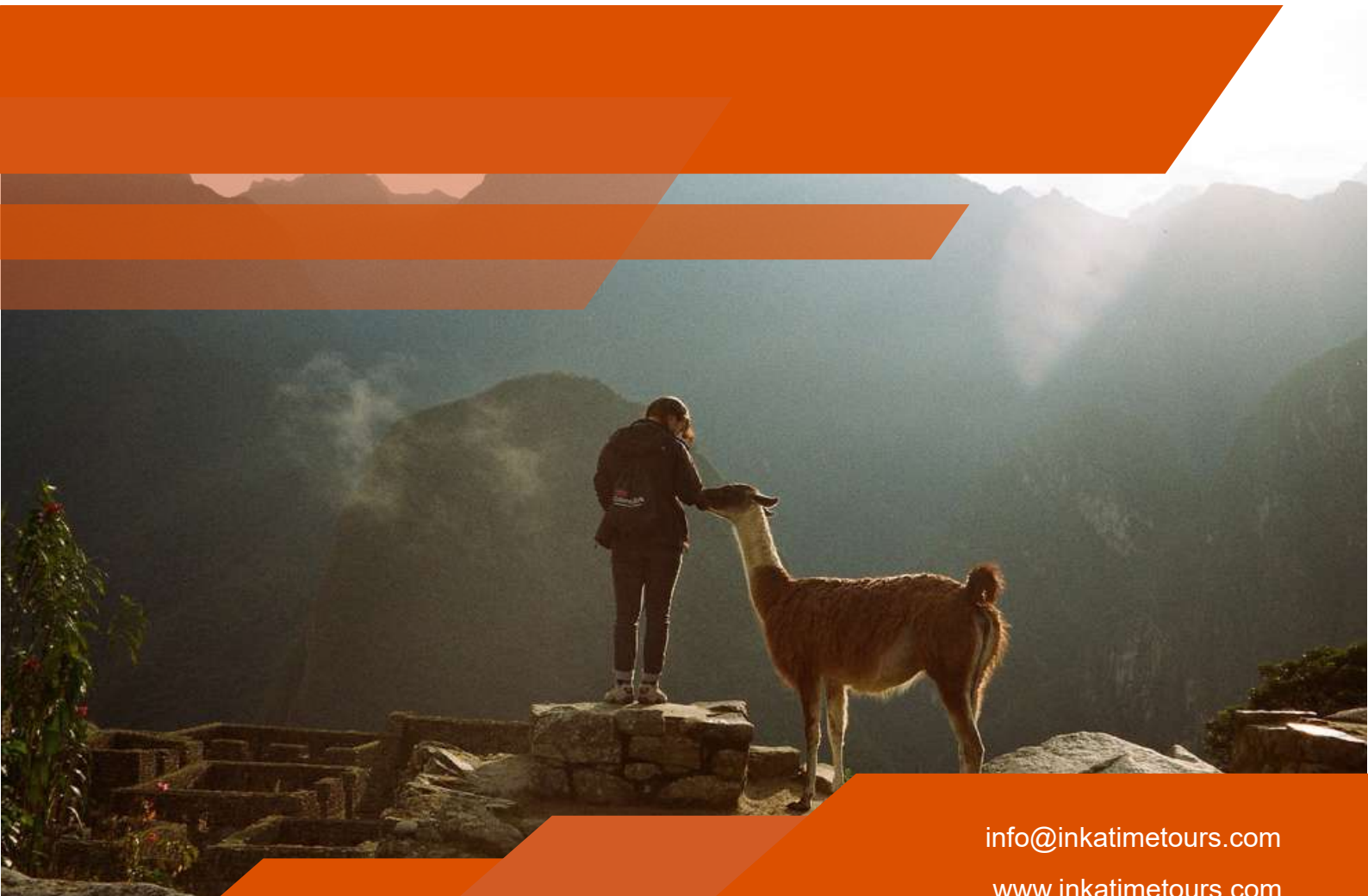
**AVAILABILITY:** EVERY DAY.

# TOUR SACRED VALLEY TO MACHU PICCHU 2 DAYS

If you don't have enough time to visit Cusco, that is not an excuse to do not enjoy the magical Sacred Valley of the Incas and having a full day in Machupicchu, in this tour you have the option to be the Inca city very early in the morning to be the first groups up there, after the 2 hour of guiding tour you'll have time to climb the Waynapicchu Mountain or to walk around the last part of the Inca Trail "IntiPunku" the SUN GATE or to go to Inca bridge, the andean world is waiting for you.



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## **DAY 1: Cusco – Chinchero – Moray – Salineras – Aguas Calientes (Machu Picchu).**

We'll pick you up from your hotel (7:00 hours) and we'll leave to visit the Sacred Valley of the Incas, After Machupicchu this is another really good option to visit, the views, people, local markets and the awesome Inca sites make this tour an unforgettable experience, you'll visit the Chinchero a Colonial village that keeps a nice Church with mural paintings and an Inca remains, this sector is one of the higher place of Cusco, with this beautiful landscapes you will arrive in Moray, this place was a kind of greenhouse for Incas, where they acclimatized different product to take those to other regions, then we will take you to the Salt Mines (Salineras), here there are more than 4000 fountain of natural salt that are still being worked by local people, after visit this place we'll continue to Arrive in Urubamba where you'll have a free time to have lunch, then following the Wilcamayu River

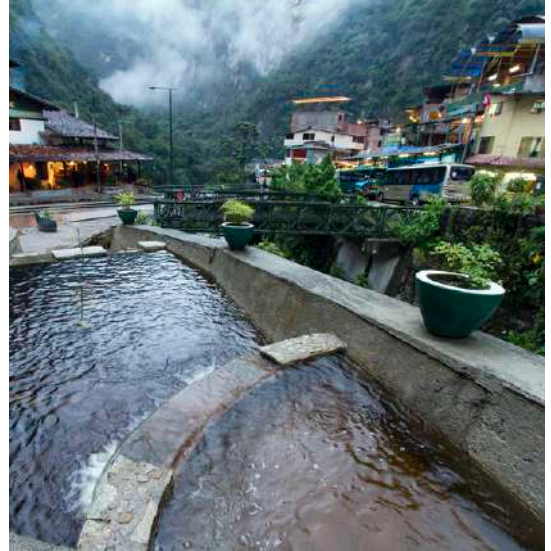


(Sacred River) you we will arrive in Ollantaytambo, the other Inca site where you'll find one of the few places in Cusco and Peru where people continue living on the Inca Construction, almost all their streets have water channels; the religious site is located at the top where the temple of the sun is stand; In this place you'll finish the tour approximately at 15:00 hours, after a short free time you have to go the train station of Ollantaytambo, the train station is located to 7 minutes walking from the square of Ollantaytambo, this is the most popular place in this site, there, you'll take the train to AGUAS CALIENTES (town of Machupicchu – 1 and 1/2 hours), once you arrive, the hostel's staff will be waiting for you with the name of the accommodation, arriving in the hostel you'll meet with the guide of Machupicchu to talk about the visit of the next day.



## DAY 2: Aguas Calientes – Machupicchu - Aguas Calientes – Cusco.

You'll have breakfast in the hostel, after you have the option to go up early to Machupicchu, you'll take a bus to arrive there in 25 minutes, the guide will be waiting for you at the archaeological site of Machupicchu, then you'll start the guiding tour, you'll be with the guide 02 hours, this will give you information around the most important areas of the citadel, then you'll have free time (the park is open until 17:00 hours) in this free time you'll have option to visit Machupicchu by your own and if you want to climb up to Waynapicchu Mountain or Machupicchu Mountain (optional hikes of 2 or 3 and 1/2 hours), after the free time we have to go down to Aguas Calientes town (by bus) and you'll have free time to go to have lunch, then you have to be ready to take the train to return, train leaves at 19:00 hours (you can ask for other earlier train times), you have to be half an hour before at the train station, this train will take you to Ollantaytambo (1 and 1/2 hours), there we'll pick you up to bring you back by bus to Cusco (01 and 1/2 hours) you'll be in Cusco again at 22:30 hours (night in Cusco).



## Included:

- **Briefing:** A day before the tour we give you detailed information about your itinerary, where we also give you all the tickets that you will need on the trip, maps and all the relevant information that you have to know, this can be at your hotel or in our office INKA TIME.
- **Tourist transportation:** The transportation to go around the sacred valley are provided with minibusses of 15 or 20 people (Renault Master or Sprinter Mercedes Benz).
- **Tour Guide in the Sacred Valley:** You will be well informed by our guides at each place of visit.
- **The entrance tickets:** We will have ready for you all tickets you need for all the sites around the Sacred Valley.
- **Train tickets:** We will book your round trip train tickets (Train Voyager IncaRail).
- **Bus Tickets:** We will give you ready tickets to go up and down in Machu Picchu (Day 2).
- **Entrance ticket to Machu Picchu:** We will have ready your passes to get into this beautiful place.
- **Tour guide (Machu Picchu):** Our guides will make you spend an excellent time in this wonderful place
- **Transportation to come back to Cusco:** Transportation in minibusses of 15 or 19 people.

## Not Included:

- **Meals:** There is a great variety of restaurants from US\$ 8.
- **Night in accommodation in Aguas Calientes:** if you wish we can give you Accommodation rates from US \$ 15 per person or you can also visit [www.booking.com](http://www.booking.com) where you have an endless number of accommodations; remember that you will arrive at the village at 18:10 a.m. and Next day they leave early to visit Machupicchu, so the accommodation is more for sleeping).
- **Entrance fee to Waynapicchu mountain:** US\$ 15.00 (this is a hiking of 2 and an 1/2 hours) if you want to climb up this mountain you have to tell us before, because there are only 400 spaces per day.
- **Entrance fee to Machupicchu mountain:** US\$ 15.00 (this is a hiking of 3 and an 1/2 hours) if you want to climb up this mountain you have to tell us before, because there are only 400 spaces per day.
- **Tips:** This is optional, our staff is well remunerated, this is why, it is not something indispensable or expectant, any amount will be well received.

## Important:

- US\$ 25.00 Discount for people belong to Andean Community group (Perú, Colombia, Ecuador y Bolivia).
- US\$ 20.00 Off for those students with Under graduated student card, (this ID must be made in PVC material and it must have the next requirements: university information, personal student information, student picture, and expiration date valid only for one year, it year must coincide with the year that student visit Machu Picchu, the discount until 25 years old.), the ISIC cards are not valid any more.
- US\$ 20.00 Discount for under 18 years old.
- US\$ 115.00 Discount for under 8 years old childrens; childrens under 3 years old do not pay if they don't occupy seats in the train and buses.
- According to the new regulation of Sustainable Use and Tourist Visit for the conservation of the Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu 2019, the entrance ticket to Machu Picchu is valid only for a single entry to the park (this means: The passenger enter, walk around, go out and can not re-enter again), usually all people stay between 4 to 5 hours into Machu Picchu, if you would like to stay a longer time, you must buy another ticket (US\$ 50.00 Extra), the park is open until 17:30 hrs.Prices are for tours in shared service (group tour), groups of 15 to 20 people, inquire for prices in private tour.
- We have departure every day.
- To start this tour you have to be at least one day before in Cusco.

## Upgrade:

- **Private Transportation to Return:** From Ollantaytambo to Cusco US\$ 20.00 (Per way, per person); This gives you a pleasant trip without waiting and picking up other people of the group tour.
- **Private Tour Guide:** Personalized service in the citadel of Machu Picchu, US\$ 25.00 (Per person - At least 2 people), with this service you will not have to depend on a group.
- **Train to return at 16:12 hrs.** TRAIN 360° Inca Rail (From Aguas Calientes to Ollantaytambo) US\$ 30.00 (Per Person); This is another class of train with Taller and wider panoramic windows and an outdoor observatory wagon with bar, this has an excellent schedule, you will arrive in Cusco around 20:20 hrs.
- **Train to Return at 16:43 hrs.** TRAIN VISTADOME - Peru Rail (From Aguas Calientes to Ollantaytambo) US\$ 35.00 (Per Person); This is another class of train with panoramic windows located beside and above your seat will bring you close to nature unlike anything you've experienced before, this has an excellent schedule, you will arrive in Cusco around 21:00 hrs.

## What you need to take

- The tickets that are given in the briefing a day before your trip.
- Original Passport (This is requested to take the trains, the buses and to get into Machupicchu).
- small rucksack (backpack) smaller than 30 liters.
- Repellent for Mosquitos.
- Sunscreen.
- Water, Snacks.
- Rain Poncho (The climate is quite changeable it is better to be forewarned).
- Comfortable clothes (somewhat warm) when you leave early and return late is a bit cold, it's better to feel comfortable with your temperature.

## TOUR IN SHARED SERVICE

This service in a GROUP TOUR means that you will do the tour with other people, This standard service has 15 to 19 participants, that doesn't mean you have to get that quantity of people to do the tour, we have confirmed departures every day, so, If you are only one or two people do not worry, you can join some of our groups.
